The Department of Chemistry at Oregon State University seeks candidates for a full-time, 9-month, tenure-track faculty position. The preferred starting date is Fall, 2008; an earlier date may be accommodated. Candidates will be considered at the Assistant, Associate and Full Professor rank depending on qualifications. The selected candidate is expected to develop and maintain a strong, independent research program and to contribute to undergraduate and graduate instructional programs. Salary is competitive, and benefits package includes several options for health/dental/life insurance, retirement and a tuition reduction program (some restrictions apply).

The Department of Chemistry offers B.A., B.S., M.A., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees. It has approximately 75 graduate students, 175 undergraduate majors and actively participates in the general education program of OSU. The department is seeking to add to its research and teaching strength in the area of organic chemistry relevant to biology, synthesis, and/or materials.

The College of Science comprises 16 academic departments and programs that offer 17 disciplinary degrees, containing 45 options among them, as well as 11 pre-professional options. Science is one of the university's largest academic units with approximately 300 faculty, 465 graduate students, 2796 undergraduate students, and 100 management service and classified personnel. Additionally, these faculty and students collaborate in three of the university's world-class research centers, namely the Linus Pauling Institute, the Environmental Health Sciences Center, and the Center for Genome Research and Biocomputing. The College supports seven partnerships that bring science and mathematics education to the teachers, students, and parents in Oregon's K-12 community. The total annual instructional and research budget supporting the College of Science is approximately \$35,000,000.
